- 1. Public piped sewerage facilities are not available to serve the proposal.
- 2. The proposed development would be premature by reason of the said existing deficiency in the provision of sewerage facilities and the period within which such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.
- 3. The proposed septic tank drainage arrangements would not be satisfactory or acceptable because of the likely pollution by the liquid waste from the said system of the nearby stream, which is a source of public water supply. The proposed development would, therefore, be prejudicial to public health.
- 4. The development proposed is not in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area in that it is not in accordance with the proposals included in the Council's Development Plan for this area which envisages the preservation of these lands as high amenity open space in the Dublin Mountain Reservation. The development proposed would not accord with this policy and would be seriously injurious to the amenities of the area.
