

1. That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required. The curtilage boundaries and location of the proposed structures must be in conformity with the attached site plan, Index No. 9143/5 dated 23rd September, 1971, provided by Dublin Corporation, Development Department. Any adjustment to the site boundaries at the north side, for the purposes of facilitating the proposed Eastern Health Board site, is to be agreed with Dublin Corporation Development Department.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be strictly adhered to in the development. The premises are not to be occupied until the Chief Fire Officer's requirements are ascertained and met.	2. To protect the safety of persons occupying or employed in the structure or any adjoining structure.
