	In pursurance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order 12964/74  decide to refuse:  PERMISSION; PERMISSION; APPROVAL,  Proposed bungalow at Colmanstown, Blackchurch.
	for the following reasons:
	1. It is an objective of the Planning Authority as expressed in the Development Plan that the area in which the site is located be preserved for the further development of agriculture. A dwelling as proposed on this site would be incompatible with this use zoning objective and would militate against the preservation of the rural environment and the Council's policy of encouraging rural development into existing village nuclei.
7,00	2. The fact that there is not a full junction off the Dublin/ Naas Dual Carriageway and the minor road serving this site would result in vehicular traffic travelling from Dublin being compelled to make a U-turn at the Athgoe junction with the Dual carriageway. A similar situation would arise with traffic leaving the site of the proposed development with Southern destinations as such

section. Such traffic turning movements would result in the creation of a serious traffic hazard and be incompatible with proper traffic design standards.

3. The proposal does not comply with the Sanitary requirements as the locations of the proposed septic tank and proposed water supply have not been separated to the satisfaction of the Sanitary Authority.
