A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

Proposed retention of existing sports pavillion and use of lands

on sports fields at Killinarden Road, Old Bawn, Tallaght.

Plot Area: 2,680-sq.ft. Site Area: 15.51-acres.

Conditions

Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.

1. To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control be maintained.

2. That the structure shall be removed on or before the 31st April, 1979, unless before that date permission for its retention is granted by the Planning Authority or by the Minister on appeal.

2. To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.

3. That a financial contribution in the sum of £134 (One hundred and thirty four pounds) be paid by the applicant to the County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development, and which facilitate this development, this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

3. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

4. That the drainage arrangements including the design, location and satisfactory operation of the septic tank be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. The applicant's must consult with the Health Inspectors Department, 9 Rutland Place with regard to these matters.
