In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/1035/74 dated 11th April, 1974 decide to refuse:

OUTLINE PERMISSION; ~~PERMISSION~~; ~~APPROVAL~~.

for Proposed extension of existing structures at Wilton Works,
Naas Road. Site area: 8.8-acres. Floor area: 105,000-sq.ft.
for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development is premature because a road layout for the area has not been approved by the Planning Authority or by the Minister for Local Government on appeal.
2. The plans submitted do not clearly indicate the existing uses, floor areas, and related off-street car-parking arrangements or the proposed uses, floor areas, and related off-street car-parking.

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NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
