Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.

2. That the revisions and ancillary services to be constructed in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.

3. That the connecting link road shown on the plans submitted between Water Meadow Drive and Cois na Habann be omitted and a connecting link road between Cois na Habann and Old Bawn Avenue to be constructed to the standards and specifications of the County Council to the junction with Old Bawn Avenue. The connecting link road between Old Bawn Avenue and Lis na Sidhe is to be omitted so as to provide for adequate separation for vehicle movements between the East and West portions of the Estate. Pedestrian paths are to be agreed with the Planning Authority.

4. That Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained, and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

1. To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.

2. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
