3. That the water supply and drainage arrangements including the disposal of surface water be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. The applicants must consult with the Sanitary Services Department with regard to these matters.	3. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
4. That all necessary measures be taken by the contractor to prevent the spillage or deposit of clay, rubble or other debris on adjoining roads during the course of the development.	4. To protect the amenities of the area.
5. That no less than thirty two No. car spaces to be provided.	5. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

6. That the proposed minimum access arrangements to the Distributor Road "B" should provide for possible combined arrangements for both school and the adjoining church site. Provisions should also be made for a bus sitting-down bay on this Distributor Road "B" adjoining this main access. The applicants must agree the details of the main school access and internal road dimensions with the Roads Engineer.

6. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

7. That Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained, and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.
