APPEAL by Naiden Properties Limited, of 16 South Frederick Street, Dublin, against a decision made on the 18th day of May, 1973, by the Right Honourable the Lord Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of Dublin deciding to refuse to grant a permission for the retention of an advertising hoarding on the gable wall of No. 8, St. Mary's Terrace, Rathfarnham, Dublin.

DECISION: Pursuant to subsection (5) of section 26 of the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, and after consideration of the report of the person who conducted an oral hearing of the said appeal, permission is hereby refused for the retention of the said advertising hoarding for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The advertising hoarding is out of character with the adjoining terrace of houses, is a strident feature in the street scene, and its retention would be injurious to the visual amenity of the area.

Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Local Government to whom the relevant powers and duties of the said Minister under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, are delegated by the Local Government (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) (No. 2) Order, 1973.
