A Chara,

With reference to your Planning Application received on the 26th November, 1970, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, the following information must be submitted in triplicate:

1. Additional information is required giving details of the present use of the premises.
2. Details are required as to the proposed use of the proposed extension.
3. The number and sex of the existing and anticipated work-force are required.
4. Details of existing and proposed off street car-parking arrangements.
5. Details are required of the volume and type of any trade effluent and the specific proposals for the control of air pollution from the emission of fumes, dust and smell, together with noise reduction measures, so as to prevent danger to health and injury to amenity.

NOTE: The applicant is advised to consult with the planning authority before submitting further plans for approval.
