That the structures shall be removed on or before the 1st February, 1974, unless before that date permission for the retention granted by the planning Authority or the Minister for Local Government on appeal.	1. In order to comply with the provisions of the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963
2. That details of the proposed toilet block shall be submitted to and approved by the County Council.	2. In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.
3. That use of the structures as classrooms is not to commence until the Chief Fire Officer's requirements are met.	3. In the interests of public health and the avoidance of fire hazard.
4. That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the provision of adequate toilet facilities, for both males and females be provided in accordance with the requirements of Sanitary Services Department, Dublin County Council.	4. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1978 - 1964.
5. That the proposed structures shall be sited a minimum distance of 35ft. from the road boundary.	5. In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area

Note: The applicant must consult with the Sanitary Services Department, Dublin County Council, with regard to condition No. 4 above before any constructional work commences on the site.
