- 1. The retention of this extension would give rise to over usage of this industrial site, the space of which is restricted by the existing large industrial buildings, offices, and septic tanks, along with the need for adequate parking, circulations, and loading/unloading space, and as such rould not be in resping with the proper planning and develo ment of the area and would be seriously injurious to the amenities of the area.
- 2. This development by reason of its size and obtrusive appearance immediately adjoining the public road, is a serious injury to the amenities of the area.
- 3. The proposed development without adequate off-street car-parking and loading/unloading facilities would create a serious traffic hazard by reason of the additional vahicular traffic movements to and from the site on this heavily trafficked County road.
- 4. There are no public piped sewerage facilities available to serve the proposal.
- 5. The proposed development is premature by reason of the said existing deficiency in the provision of sewerage facilities and the period within which such facilities are reasonably expected to be made good.
