2. Approval under the Building Byo-laws to be obtained, and all conditions of that approval to be observed in the development.

2. To achieve a satisfactory standard of development.

3. The entire premises to be used as a single dwelling unit.

4. All external finishes to harmonise in colour and texture with the existing premises.

4. In the interest of visual amenity.

5. That the rights of adjoining property owners shall not be infringed by the development.
