3. The premises to be used as a single dwelling unit.
4. All external finishes to correspond in colour and texture with the existing premises.
5. That the rights and permissions of adjoining owners shall not be infringed.

1. To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. To achieve a satisfactory standard of development.
3. To prevent unauthorised development.
4. In the interest of visual amenity.
5. In the interest of residential amenity.
