In pursuance of its functions under the above-mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by Order dated as above make a decision to grant Permission / Approval for

proposed residential development (50 No. dwellinghouses) at Lucan

Floor area - 50,000 sq. ft. (1,000 sq. ft. each)

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS :

Conditions

Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as to the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the existing proposed dwellinghouses on 1-10 inclusive, fronting to the Lucan/Newcastle Road and on site Nos. 2 and 3, fronting to Road No. 7, be omitted from the development at this stage, pending clarification of the Roads Department's requirements with regard to road improvement lists, land reservations and access and that any necessary revisions to the layout be submitted to and approved by the Council.
3. That adequate off-street car-parking spaces be provided in respect of each dwelling house.
4. That the proposed dwellinghouses be set back not less than 30-ft. from the road boundaries, save in exceptional circumstances.
5. That the relevant conditions Nos. 3 to 19 inclusive, imposed by order No. 4/1793/70, dated 1st September, 1970 whereby a decision to grant permission for the development works on these lands was made by the Council, be adhered to. In respect of this permission.
6. That Building By-Laws approval shall be obtained, and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.

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4. In the interests of amenity.

5. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.

6. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
