A Chara,

With reference to your planning application received here on the 1st October, 1970, in connection with the above development, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, the following information must be submitted in triplicate:-

1. The proposed use of the existing mastic/asphalt plant on the site is required.
2. Details of the specific proposals for the control of air pollution from the emission of fumes and dust, together with noise reduction measures so as to prevent danger to health and injury to amenity are required.
3. Details of waste products and effluents both aerial and liquid are required.
4. Details of equipment and proposed means of dealing with effluents and wastes are required.
5. The number and sex of the existing and anticipated workforce are required.
6. The anticipated output (daily) from the plant and also the anticipated daily traffic generation.
7. Revised plans are required providing for a more acceptable layout of the plant in relation to the adjoining dwelling houses for the purpose of preserving and improving the amenities of the residential properties.

Note: The applicant is advised to consult with the Roads Department, Sanitary Services Department, and Planning Department, before submitting further plans for approval.
