Conditions

Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.

2. That the proposed structure be set back not less than 50 ft. from the existing highway boundary.

2. In the interest of amenity.

3. That the means of disposal of both solid and liquid waste from the stables together with the ancillary drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.

3. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.

4. That Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.

4. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.

5. The structure to be used solely for the purpose of stabling animals.

5. To prevent unauthorized development.
