That the design and location of the proposed septic tank including the excavation and satisfactory inspection of all necessary trial holes be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council; the applicants must consult with the Chief Medical Officer's Department, 6 Parnell Square, with regard to these requirements.

3. That Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained, and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.
