1. That the proposed structure shall be used solely for testing and developing air-compressors for light industry as set out in the applicants letter received the 25th September, 1970, and that any proposed change of usage shall be subject to the approval of the County Council or the Minister for Local Government on appeal.
2. That Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained, and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.
