3. That the drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council and that the applicant consult with the Sanitary Services Department, before work is commenced on the site.
4. That adequate car-parking facilities for not less than 16 cars be provided on the site.
5. That Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained, and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.
