1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. That the necessary land required for road improvement purposes be reserved as such and that the proposed improvement line and the relevant house location be set out and agreed with the council's Roads Department.	2. In the interest of proper planning and development of the area.
3. That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the design and location of the proposed septic tank together with the excavation and inspection of all necessary trial holes be in accordance with the requirements of the county council; the applicant must consult with the Chief Medical Officer's Department, 6 Parnell Square, in this regard.	3. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
4. That a financial contribution in the sum of £25. be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.	4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
5. That Building By-Laws approval shall be obtained and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.	5. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
