Applicant:

In pursuance of its functions under the above-mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by Order dated as above make a decision to grant Permission/Approval for the proposed housing development at Oldham Road, Tallaght.

## SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

### Conditions

1. That the development be carried out in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application save as is in the conditions otherwise required.
2. Approval under the Building bye-laws to be obtained in any condition of that approval to be observed in the development.
3. That the water supply and drainage arrangements shall be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council's Sanitary Authority.
4. That the requirements of the Fire Prevention Officer.
5. That a building line of 50 ft. minimum shall be left by, or carried to in this development.
6. That a building line of 50 ft. minimum shall be observed in this development.
7. A 6 ft. screen wall, suitably copped and rendered shall be erected to the side of site No. 4 across the rear gardens of the adjoining dwellings to give a public view.
8. A 6 ft. screen wall, suitably copped and rendered shall be erected between houses to the front.
9. A screen wall 6 ft. high, suitably copped and rendered shall be constructed between site No. 1 and the adjoining dwelling.
10. Details of front boundary treatment shall be submitted to and approved by the Council's Planning Committee.

### Reasons for Conditions

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. To achieve a satisfactory standard of development.
3. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
4. In the interest of public safety.
5. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
