Conditions

Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.

1. To ensure that the development is in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.

2. That the drainage arrangements with particular regard to the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council, where applicable.

2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.

3. That all necessary measures be taken by the contractor to prevent the spillage or deposit of clay, rubble or other debris on the adjoining roads during the course of the works.

3. To protect the amenities of the area.

4. That the proposed underpass and ancillary road works be constructed in accordance with the agreed programming and requirements of the County Council's Roads Department and that all necessary precautions be taken to minimise any hazard to the travelling public on the Haas Road dual-carriageway during the period of construction; the applicants must consult with the Council's Roads Department, with regard to these matters.

4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

5. That Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained, and any condition of such approval to be observed in the development.

5. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
