1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specifications lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. That the necessary land required for the Council's future road proposals in the area shall be reserved as such and shall be set out on site and agreed with the Council's Road Department before any construction work is undertaken on the site.	2. In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.
3. That the proposed factory shall be used for the assembly of low tension transformers and offices only and any proposed change of use shall be subject to the approval of the County Council or the Minister for Local Government on appeal.	3. In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.
4. That the water supply and drainage arrangements shall be in accordance with the requirements of Dublin County Council.	4. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
5. That the requirements of the Council's Fire Prevention Officer shall be adhered to in the development before use of the building commences.	5. In the interests of public safety and avoidance of fire hazard.
6. That off-street car-parking facilities for a minimum number of 55 cars shall be provided on the site.	6. In the interests of proper planning and development.
7. That all necessary measures be taken by the contractor to prevent the spillage or deposit of clay, rubble or other debris on adjoining roads during the course of the works.	7. To protect the amenities of the area.
8. That the proposed site shall be landscaped to the satisfaction of the County Council.	8. In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.
9. That Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be adhered to in the development.	9. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
