In pursuance of its functions under the above-mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by Order dated as above make a decision to grant Permission/Approval for

Proposed Bungalow at Luscan Road, Palmerstown.

Conditions

Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the water supply and drainage arrangements shall be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
3. That the external finishes including the roof shall harmonise in colour and texture with the existing development.
4. That Building Bye Laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

Prior to the commencement of the development a sum of Fifty two pounds (£52) to be paid to Dublin County Council in respect of piped water and sewerage which have facilitated the development.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
3. In the interest of amenity.
4. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964
5. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
