In pursuance of its functions under the above-mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the proposed construction of sewer line Lower Ballymount Road, Walkinstown.

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

Conditions

1. That the development shall be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the requirements of the Sanitary Services Department, Dublin County Council, shall be strictly observed in the proposed development.
3. That the necessary measures shall be taken by the developer to prevent spilling or deposit of clay or rubble on adjoining roads during the course of the work.
4. That Building Bye Laws approval shall be obtained and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.
