3. That the requirements of the Council's Fire Prevention Officer shall be strictly adhered to in the development, and that these be carried out before use of the building commences.	3. In the interest of public safety and avoidance of fire hazard.
4. That the external finishes should harmonize in colour and texture with the existing development.	4. In the interests of visual amenity.
5. That all necessary measures be taken by the contractor to prevent spillage or deposit of clay, rubble or other debris on adjoining roads during the course of the works.	5. To protect the amenities of the area.
6. That Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained, and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.	6. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
