3. That the requirements of the Council's Fire Prevention Officer be adhered to in the development.	3. In the interest of public safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
4. That any necessary land required for road improvement purposes be reserved as such.	4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
5. That adequate traffic visibility be provided at the entrance to the site from Stocking Lane so as to provide for safe vehicular movement to and from the golf course.	5. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
6. That Building Bye Laws approval shall be obtained and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.	6. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
