Reasons for Conditions

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. Approval under the Building Bye-laws to be obtained, and all conditions of that approval to be observed in the development.
3. The premises to be used as a single dwelling unit.
4. All external finishes to harmonise in colour and texture with the existing premises.
5. That the rights and permissions of the adjoining property owners shall not be infringed.
6. That the window at the side of the proposed extension shall be glazed with a frosted or suitable non-frosted glass.

2. To achieve a satisfactory standard of development.
3. To prevent unauthorised development.
4. In the interest of visual amenity.
5. In the interest of amenity.
6. To preserve the amenities of the existing residential properties.
