SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS

Conditions

- (1) That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
- (2) That the design and location of the house and proposed septic tank together with all relevant trial holes be in accordance with the requirements of the county council; the applicant must consult with the Chief Medical Officer's Department, 6, Parnell Square, with regard to this matter.
- (3) That a satisfactory landscaping scheme be submitted to and approved by County Council.
- (4) That Building Bye Laws approval shall be obtained and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.

Reasons for Conditions

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
3. In the interest of amenity.
