- (3) That a satisfactory landscaping scheme be submitted to and approved by the County Council.
- (4) That Building Bye Laws approval shall be obtained and any condition or such approval shall be observed in the development.

- 1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
- 2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
- 3. In the interest of amenity.
