SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the requirements of the council's Fire Prevention Officer be adhered to in the Development.
3. That the water supply and drainage arrangements shall be in accordance with the requirements of the county council.
4. The applicants must provide written proof that nuisance will not be caused at any time by the emission of trade wastes or effluents; the applicant must consult with the Chief Medical Officer's Department in this regard.
5. That Building Bye-Laws approval shall be obtained and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.

Reasons for Conditions

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. In the interest of public safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
3. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
4. In the interest of public health and amenity.
5. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
