In pursuance of its functions under the above-mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by Order dated as above make a decision to grant Permission ~~Approval~~ for proposed replacement of existing 38kv Transmission Line from Gibbons townland to support 38kv Transformer Station at Slade

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS :

Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the proposed new masts be not erected within 50-ft. of any proposed road reservation for road improvement purposes; the applicants must consult with the Council's Roads Section before any constructional work takes place.

1. To ensure that the development is in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. In the interests of the proper Planning and Development of the area.
