Reasons for Conditions

Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as herein the conditions hereinafter otherwise required.
2. That the external finishes shading the roof shall harmonise in colour and texture with the adjoining development.
3. That no plant, vehicle or other materials be stored between the structures and the Nass Road boundary.
4. That the site be tendered to the requirements of the County Council having regard to the road improvement works to be carried out.
5. That all necessary measures be taken by the contractor to prevent the spillage of deposit of clay, or other debris on adjoining roads during the course of the work.
6. That the location and design of the septic tank approved by the Council's Sanitary Department before any work commences on the site.
7. That no access on to the Nass Road, other than the existing, be provided.
8. That Building Control approval shall be obtained, and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.
9. That the necessary land be reserved for the widening of the Nass Road.
10. That the building be set back not less than 30 ft. from the future road widening.
11. To ensure that the development is in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
12. In the interest of amenity.
