Conditions

Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the requirements of the Council's Fire Prevention Officer be strictly adhered to in the development.
3. That the water supply and drainage arrangements shall be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
4. That adequate off-street carparking and loading/unloading facilities be provided.
5. That any proposed front boundary walls, railings or gates, shall be in accordance with the design standards set out in Plan No. TP/2715 and revisions, prepared by the Dublin Planning Officer for this Industrial Estate Development.
6. That the proposed structures shall be used only for light industrial purposes, storage and offices and any proposed change of use shall be subject to the approval of the County Council or the Minister for Local Government on appeal.
7. That building bye-laws approval shall be obtained and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. In the interest of public safety, development, and the avoidance of fire hazard.
3. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
4. In the interest of the proper Planning & Development of the area.
5. In the interest of visual amenity.
6. In the interest of the proper Planning and Development of the area.
7. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
