for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development, would seriously injure the amenities of residential properties in the vicinity by reason of the noise, disturbance and smell associated with the proposed use.
2. The off-street car parking and loading/unloading facilities provided are not considered adequate for the development proposed.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn (the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
