In pursuance of its functions under the above-mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by Order dated as above make a decision to grant Permission/Approval for

PROPOSED Warehouse and Offices at John P. Kennedy Industrial

Estate Extension, Bluebell.

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
3. That the requirements of the Fire Prevention Officer, be adhered to in the development.
4. That the proposed building be set back not less than 50ft. from the revised Main Estate Road.
5. That the area between the building and the road boundary may not be used for the storage of machinery, plant and materials.
6. That no boundary fence or walling obstructing visibility over 3'6" be erected along the site boundary.
7. That the proposed structure shall be used only for warehouse and office purposes as set out in the applicants letter dated 10 July 1970 and any proposed change of use shall be subject to the approval of County Council or the Minister of appeal.
8. That Building Bye laws approval shall be obtained and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.

Reasons for Conditions

1. To ensure that the development is in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
3. In the interests of public safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
4. In the interests of proper planning and development.
