### SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

#### Conditions

1. That no constructional work be put in hand until detailed plans have been submitted to and approved by the County Council under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963.
2. That the site proposed be not less than one acre in extent.
3. That the water, supply and drainage arrangements, including the design and location of septic tank, together with all relevant trial holes, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council; the applicant must consult with the Chief Medical Officer's Department in this regard.

#### Reasons for Conditions

1. In order to comply with the provisions of the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963.
2. In the interests of public health and the proper planning and development of the area.
3. In the interests of public health and Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
