Conditions

Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the external finishes harmonise in colour and texture with the adjoining development.
3. That the rights and permissions of adjoining property owners be not infringed.
4. That the flank wind at first floor level be of opaque materials so as to preserve the amenities of the adjoining property.
5. That Building Bye-Laws Approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. In the interests of visual amenity.
3. To prevent unauthorised development.
4. In the interest of amenity.
5. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1978 - 1964.
