3. That the proposed disposal of surface water shall be in accordance with the requirements of the Dublin County Council.	3. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 & 1964.
4. That the requirements of the Council's Fire Prevention Officer shall be strictly adhered to in the proposed development.	4. In the interest of public safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
5. That adequate off-street car parking facilities and loading/unloading facilities shall be provided in connection with the proposed development.	5. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
6. That no advertising matter shall be displayed on the site or the buildings save with the prior permission of the County Council.	6. In the interest of amenity.
7. That the external finishes shall harmonise in colour and texture with the development.	7. In the interest of visual amenity.
8. That Building Bye-Laws approval shall be obtained and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.	8. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
