That the proposed structure shall be used only for the sales and servicing of earth moving machinery as set out in the letter of application dated 19th December, 1969 and any proposed change of use shall be subject to the approval of the County Council or the Minister for Local Government on appeal.	2. In the interest of the planning and development of the area.
3. That the proposed works and processes including the machinery to be installed be not detrimental to the amenities of the area by reason of noise, vibration, smell, fumes, smoke, dust, ash, dust, grit or nuisance.	3. In the interest of public health and amenity.
4. That the proposed surface water disposal shall in no way interfere with the proper functioning of the existing septic tank.	4. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services, Acts 1966-1968.
