In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/1188/70 dated 26th June, 1970 decide to refuse:

OUTLINE PERMISSION; PERMISSION; APPROVAL,  
for Proposed retention of Quarry at Shale Quarry, Lugg.

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development, which is in the Dublin Mountain zone and does not provide for a satisfactory reinstatement and landscaping programme, would seriously injure the amenities of the area.
2. Proposed development would create a serious traffic hazard on the adjoining roads by reason of the additional vehicle movement to and from the site.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.

With reference to your letter dated 10th December, 1969, regarding planning permission in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, the following information must be submitted in triplicate:-

1. Details of the existing quarrying operations and their location on these lands are required.
2. Details of the access and egress to the site are required.
3. Details of the number of employees engaged in the work and the number of vehicles and other daily movements to and from the site are required.
4. Details of the proposed scale of operations as to the applicant's proposals for the reinstatement and landscaping of these lands are also required.
