1. That the development shall be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. That the proposed bungalow shall be set back a minimum distance of 50 ft. from the existing road boundary.	2. In the interest of the proper Planning and Development in the area.
3. That the water supply and drainage arrangements including the design and location of the proposed septic tank and well shall be in accordance with the requirements of Dublin County Council.	3. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
4. That legally binding indenture sterilising the proposed 5 acre site from further building shall be submitted to, and approved by the Council before construction work is undertaken on the site.	4. In the interest of the proper Planning and Development of the area.
5. That the applicant must consult with Dublin Corporation Waterworks Department, Fishamble St., Dublin 1 with regard to the proposed septic tank location and private water supply before any constructional work takes place on this site.	5. In the interest of public health and avoidance of hazard to the public water supply system.
6. That Building Bye-Laws approval shall be obtained and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.	6. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
