With reference to your letter regarding planning permission in connection with the above, I am to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, the following information must be submitted in triplicate:-

- (1) Revised plans are required providing for the location and excavation of satisfactory trial holes after consultation and agreement with the Sanitary Authority, 6, Parnell Square, Dublin 1, with regard to the proposed method of providing septic tank drainage for the development.
- (2) Proposed source of water supply.
- (3) The relationship of any proposed septic tank or private source of water supply to the existing dwellinghouse on these lands.
