for the following reasons:

- (1) The erection of a dwelling on this site would not be in keeping with the proper planning and development of the area and would be seriously injurious to the amenities of the existing residential properties.
- (2) The proposed dwelling-house has no public road frontage.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
