In pursuance of its functions under the above-mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by Order dated as above make a decision to grant Permission/Approval for

Proposed Septic Tank at No. 10, Gortlum, Briggs.

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS

Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the requirements of the council's Health Department and particularly in regard to the placing of the proposed septic tank so as to enable the owner of the adjoining property to connect his drain to it, be strictly adhered to in the development; the applicant must consult with the Health Department 6, Parnell Square, in regard to this condition before any construction work commences on the site.
3. That Building Bye-Laws approval shall be obtained and any condition of such approval shall be observed in the development.

Reasons for Conditions

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
2. In order to comply with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority.
3. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
