2. That the external finishes, including the roof, harmonise in colour and texture with the adjoining development.	2. In the interests of visual amenity
3. That the requirements of the Council's Fire Prevention Officer be adhered to in the development.	3. In the interests of public safety and avoidance of fire hazard.
4. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.	
5. That the shop may not be used (a) as a fried fish shop, (b) for the sale of hot animals or birds or (c) for the sale or display for sale of motor vehicles other than bicycles without a special grant permission by the County Council.	5. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1970 & 1984.
6. That Building Regulation approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.	6. To prevent unauthorised development.
7. That prior to commencement of development a sum of £52 to be paid to the County Council as a contribution towards the cost of provision of services in the area of the development.	6. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1970 & 1984.
8. The applicant must consult with the Chief Medical Officer's Department, No. 6 Parnell Square, Dublin 1, with regard to that Department's requirements in respect of the shop premises.	7. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
