Reasons for Conditions

- (1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
- (2) That the external finishes harmonise in colour and texture with the existing development.
- (3) That the water supply and drainage arrangements shall be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
- (4) That the requirements of the Council's Fire Prevention Officer shall be adhered to in the development.
- (5) That Building Bye-Laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

- (1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
- (2) In the interests of visual amenity.
- (3) In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
- (4) In the interests of public safety and avoidance of fire hazards.
- (5) In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
