Conditions:

(I) That the development shall be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions

existing dwelling.

(3) That the premises shall be used as a single dwelling.

(4) That the rights and permissions of the edjoining property owners shall be not infringed.

(5) That Building Bye-Laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Covernment against this decision, permission will be granted by the Council on the expiration of the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the permission as soon as may be after the withdrawal.
