With reference to your letter received 13th August, 1969, regarding planning permission in connection with the above application, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, the following information must be submitted:-

(1) That the detailed information (including necessary plans etc.) required to be submitted for approval of the Planning Authority under conditions (1), (2), (3), (4), (6) and (7) of outline permission (Order P/789/68, dated 4th June, 1968, for quarry development at Cheeverstown, Clondalkin, be submitted.

(2) That details of existing developments, which have been carried out by Messrs. Roadstone on the site, including that at Belgard Castle, shall be submitted to the Planning Authority.

NOTE: The applicants are advised to confer with officials of the Dublin Planning Office in order to clarify planning requirements in this matter.
