(2) That the water supply and drainage arrangements particularly the design and location of the proposed septic tank to avoid any possible pollution of the adjoining stream, shall be in a coordance with the requirements of the County Council; the applicant is advised to consult with the Sanitary Authority, 6 Parnell Square, in regard to this condition before

(3) That on e single dwellinghouse only be erected on these lands.
